Places to Visit

Unspoilt and peaceful it is hard to believe that the meandering valley of Swaledale was once a centre of the lead mining industry. Walk through the little villages of Keld and Muker, visit the Castle Bolton, which is associated with Mary Queen of Scots, and or maybe browse around the thriving market town of Richmond. Wensleydale, famous for its cheese made at the village of Hawes, also has connections with James Herriot and the 'All Creatures Great and Small' T. V. series. Stunning limestone scenery is to be found in the south of the area where classic walks around the Ingleton area take you from the hilltops to the deep wooded gorges and spectacular waterfalls near the village. The Lune Valley to the West is quieter than many Dales, but no less interesting with beautiful views which inspired paintings by Turner and prompted John Ruskin to describe the landscape as some of the loveliest in the country. The area is also linked with George Fox and the Quaker movement.

At the heart of the Dales the valley of Wharfedale offers a landscape of tumbling water and winding paths leading to the village of Grassington with its cobbled streets and quaint shops, a good place to end a tour with a little browsing for those gifts to take home. With so much choice, let us help you select the places you might like to visit depending on your preferences.

The Terrain

Our walks are over open moorland, through farmland, woodland, and by rushing streams.

Where do we Stay Overnight ?

There is a wide scope of accommodation options available in the Yorkshire Dales including 'Pub Hotels' and secluded Luxury Hotels. You decide what type of accommodation you would like, and we arrange it for you from the selection of quality establishments that we know.

As an example, for a party of 4 with accommodation at £65 per person dinner, bed & breakfast, the cost per person per night would be £122.50

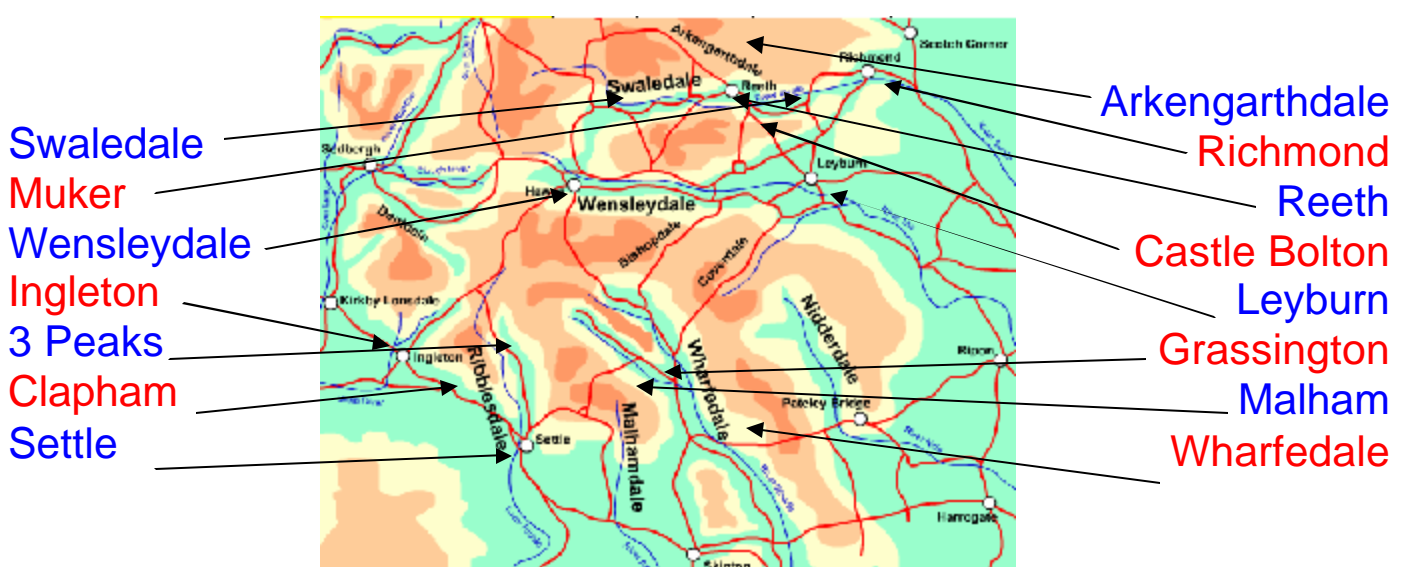
